## Payment Rates for On-Call Work Over Christmas and New Year

Questions have been raised over the interpretation of <u>PCS(AFC)2021/4</u> in respect of the payment for certain work done on-call at Christmas and New Year. Specifically, where a staff member who normally works Monday to Friday was off on the designated Public Holiday days of 27 and 28 December 2021, but was required to be on-call for Saturday 25 and Sunday 26 December 2021. In this scenario, the staff member will receive an on-call allowance and payment for any work undertaken on 25 and 26 December at the Public Holiday rate of double time.

This same principle applies to the analogous scenario for 1 and 2 January 2022.
